NDIS Appeals is a service that supports you to appeal a decision made by the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA).

### What is the NDIS Appeals Process?

There are 3 types of NDIS Appeals:

- 1. Early Plan Reviews
- 2. Internal Reviews
- 3. External Merits Reviews

Clients can ask for help at **any stage** of the NDIS Appeals process.





## How can NDIS Appeals support you?

We can help if you are unhappy with NDIA decisions on eligibility and not having enough funding.

- Therapies
- Plan management
- Support co-ordination
- Home modifications
- Any other issues
