What is NDIS Appeals?

NDIS Appeals is a service that supports you to appeal a decision made by the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA).

What is the NDIS Appeals Process?

There are 3 types of NDIS Appeals:

1. Early Plan Reviews
2. Internal Reviews
3. External Merits Reviews

Clients can ask for help at **any stage** of the NDIS Appeals process.



How can NDIS Appeals support you?

We can help if you are unhappy with NDIA decisions on eligibility and not having enough funding.

This could be issues such as:

- Therapies
- Plan management
- Support co-ordination
- Home modifications
- Any other issues

NDIS Appeals can support clients with:

- Preparing documents the NDIA may ask for
- Explaining your NDIA decision letters
- Working with the client to put in an internal review request
- Attending case conferences, conciliations and hearings
- Helping apply for Legal Aid
