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What is NDIS Appeals?

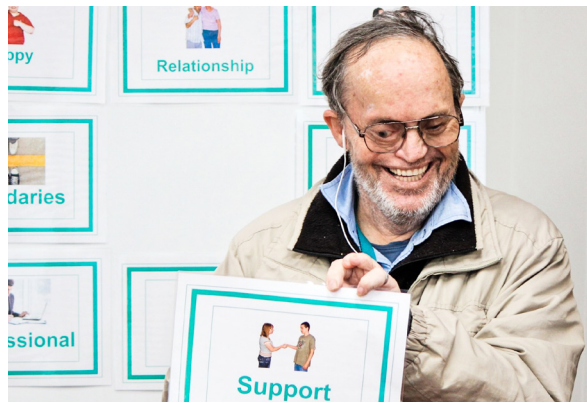
NDIS Appeals is a service that supports people with disability to appeal a decision made by the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA).

What is the NDIS Appeals process?

There are 3 types of NDIS Appeals:

1. Early Plan Reviews
2. Internal Reviews
3. External Reviews

You can ask for help at **any stage** of the NDIS Appeals process.



How can NDIS Appeals support you?

We can help you if you are unhappy with NDIA decisions.

These decisions could be about:

- eligibility
- not having enough funding
- therapies
- plan management
- support co-ordination
- home modifications

Our NDIS Appeals service is FREE

NDIS Appeals can support you with:

- preparing documents the NDIA may ask for
- explaining your NDIA decision letters
- putting in a request for an internal and external review
- attending case conferences, conciliations and hearings
- applying for Legal Aid
